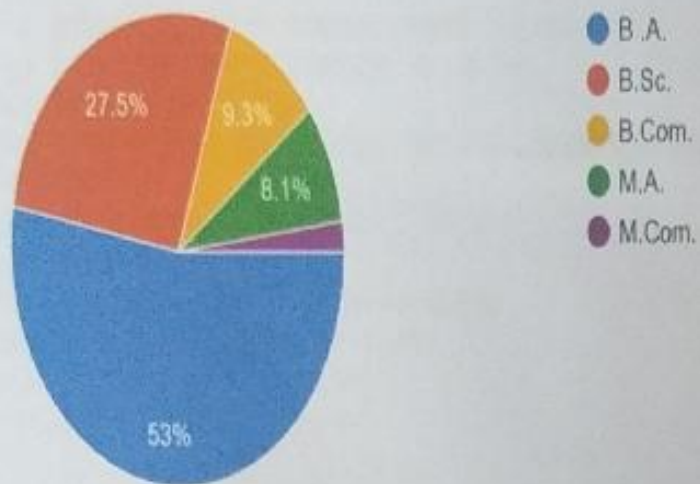

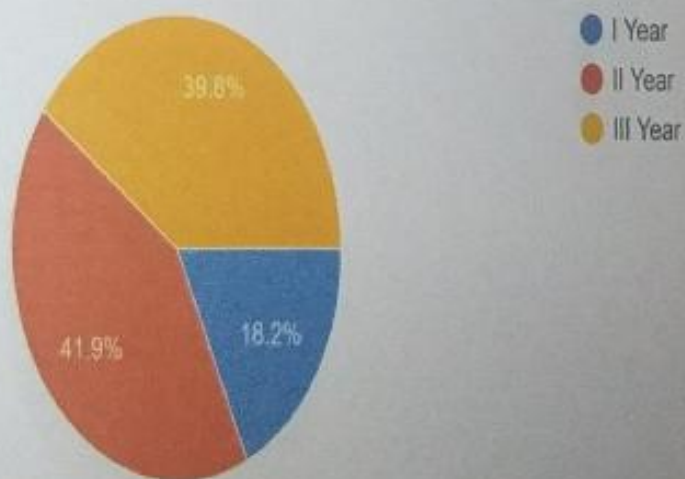

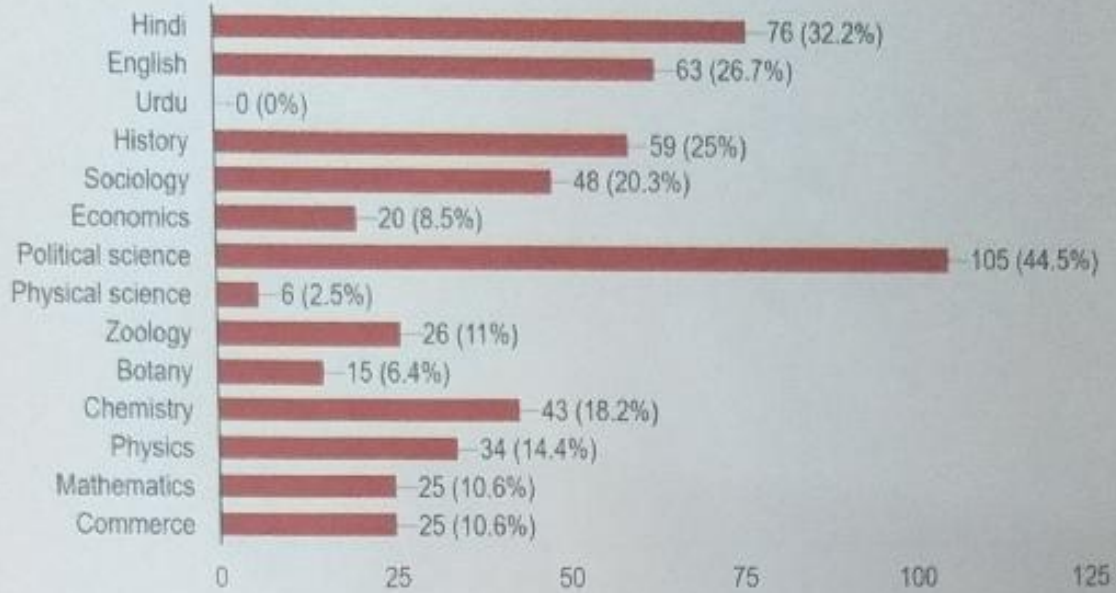

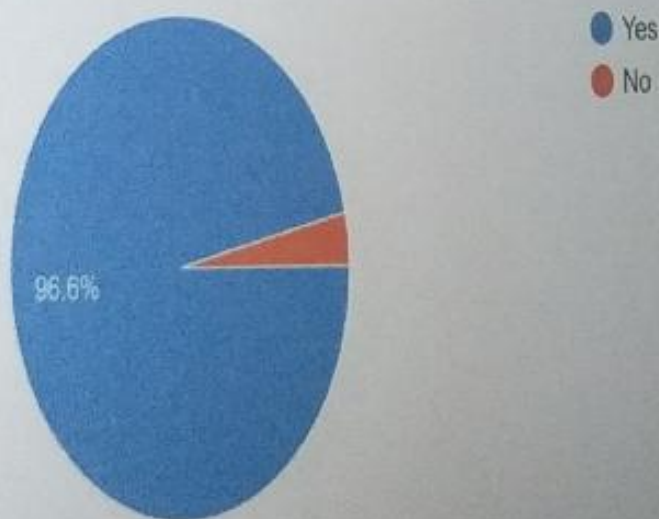

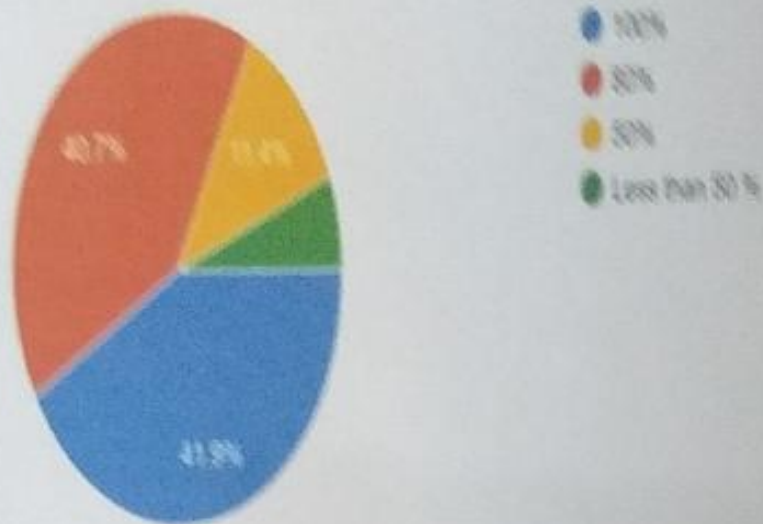
### Q.1 Syllabus is suitable to the course

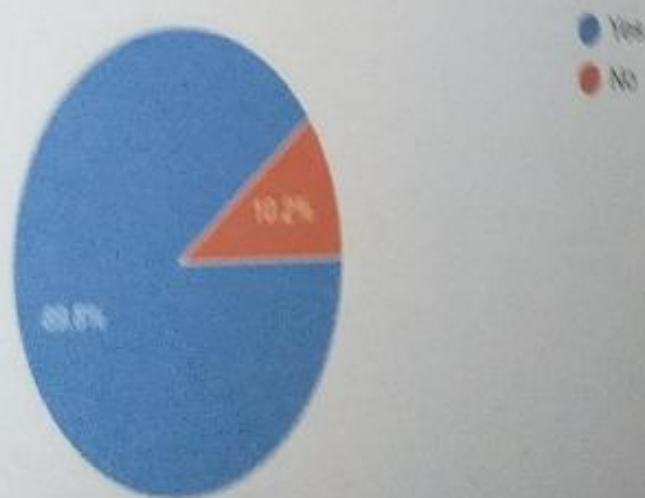
Q.2 Has the teacher covered entire syllabus as prescribed by the University?

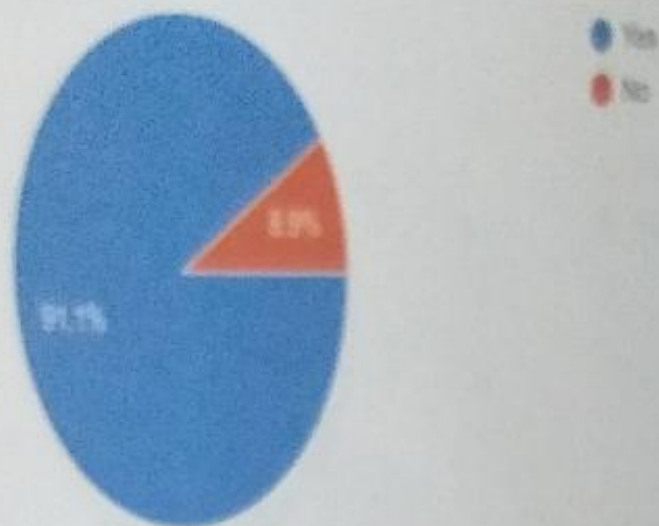
Q.3 Has the teacher covered relevant topic beyond syllabus?

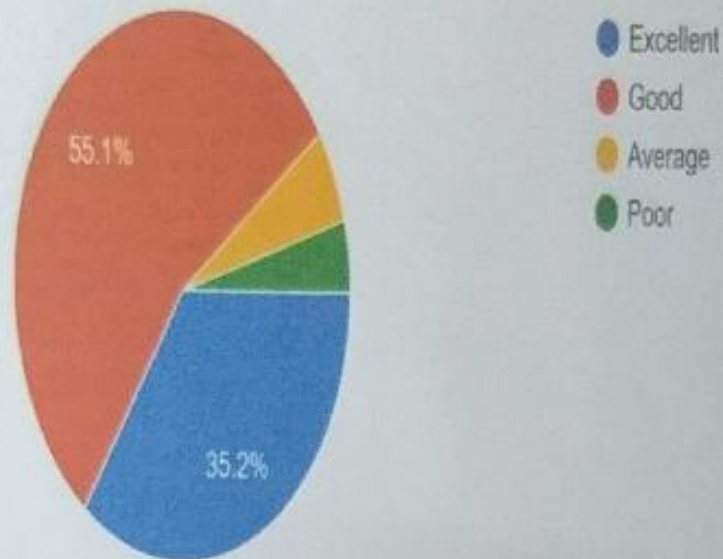
Q.5 The syllabus has good balance between theory and application

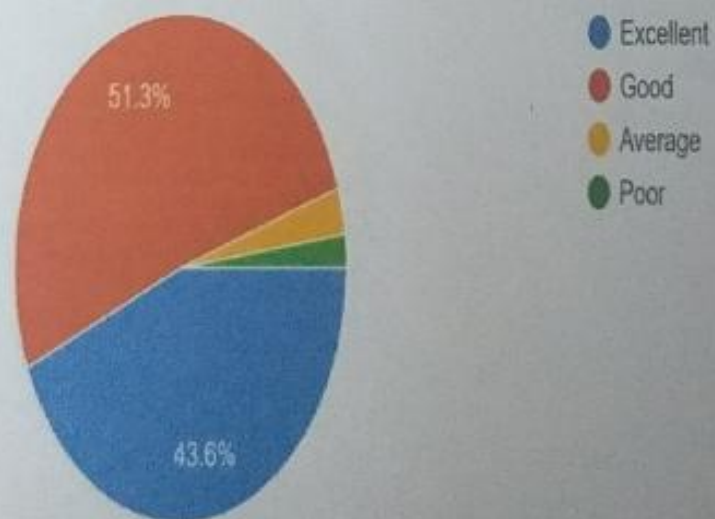
### Q.6 Teacher interaction and guidance outside the class room

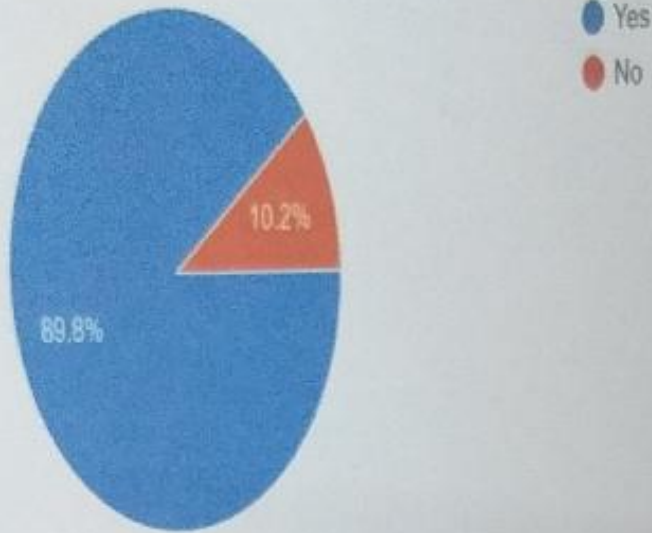
### Q.7 Communication skill of the teacher

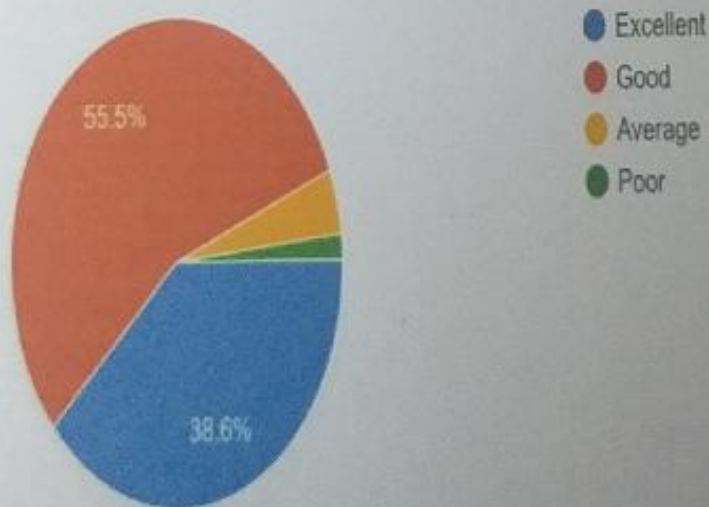
### Q.8 Uses of the innovative teaching method

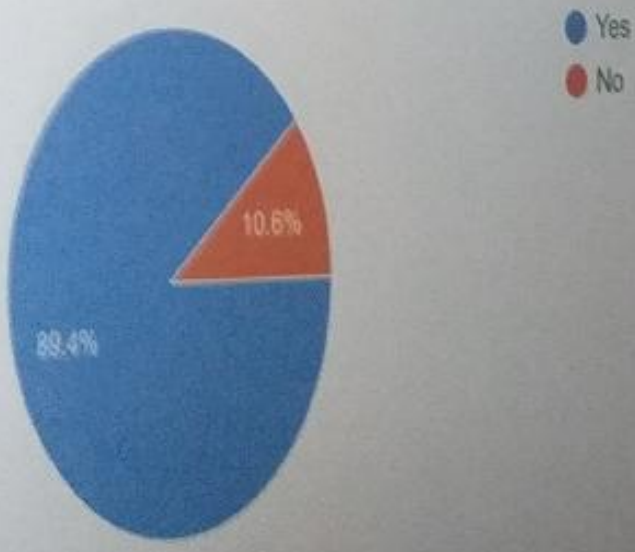
Q.10 Whether the assignments and test taken time to time are relevant and useful

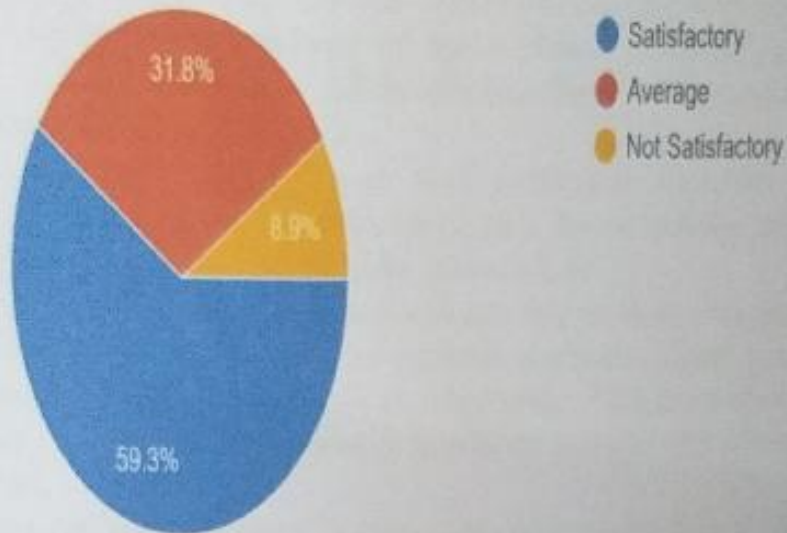

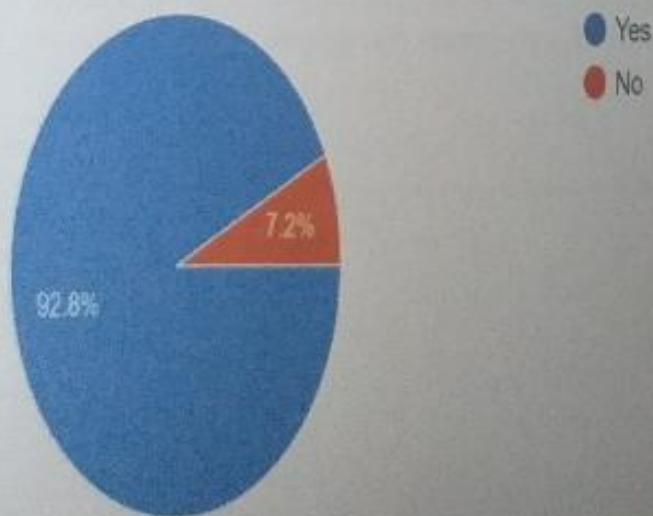
Q.12 Online education resources are available and accessible

## OBSERVATIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

- About 42 percent students agreed that the teachers covered 100 percent syllabus prescribed by the university while 41 percent students agreed on 80 percent of the syllabus. Due to covid 19, classes were taken online and offline as per the government orders & convenience of the students. Remaining syllabus were covered by taking extra classes. All faculty members instructed to complete the syllabus within the stipulated time.
- About 91 percent students stated that sufficient number of prescribed books/reading materials are available in library. More efforts are being done to motivate students to download e books from N-List.
- About 35 percent students stated that teacher interaction and guidance outside the class room is excellent while 55 percent students stated good. Remaining students gave the feedback that it is average/poor. Teachers should make more efforts to provide ample interaction & guidance outside the classrooms as well counsel them.
- About 43 percent students were in view that communication skill of teachers is excellent while 53 percent students gave feedback of good. Remaining students were in view that it was average/poor. Teachers should make efforts to improve their communication skills.
- About 90 percent students stated that teachers used innovative teachings. 10 percent were denied. Teachers were motivated to be more innovative in teaching and learning.
- About 60 percent students stated that the online resources are available and accessible are satisfactory while 32 percent students stated them average. Remaining students were in view that those were not satisfactory. Efforts are being done to make online resources more available and accessible for the students.
