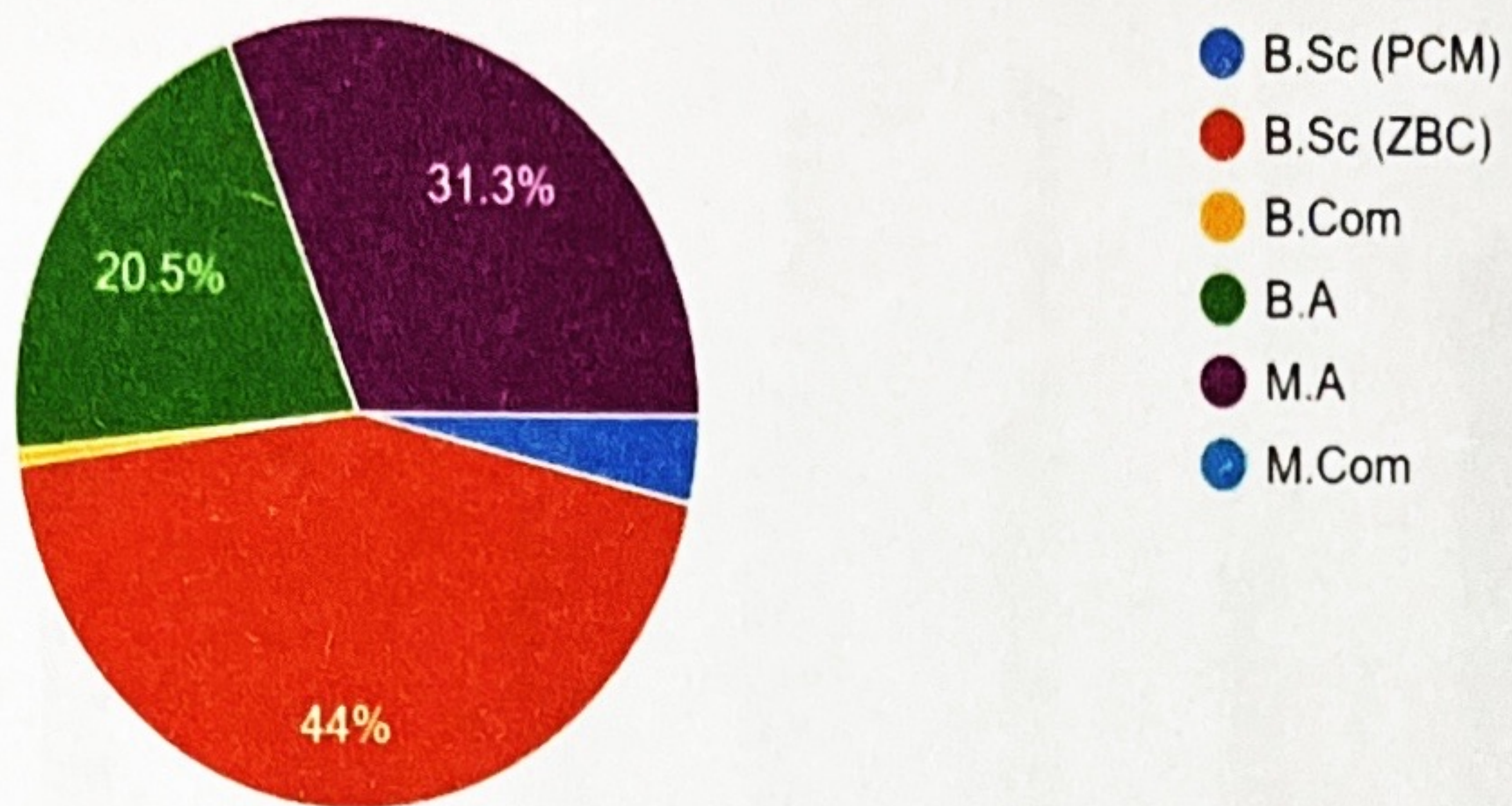
Objectives of parent's feedback on institute:

 10. Assessment about the placements and internships provided by the college.

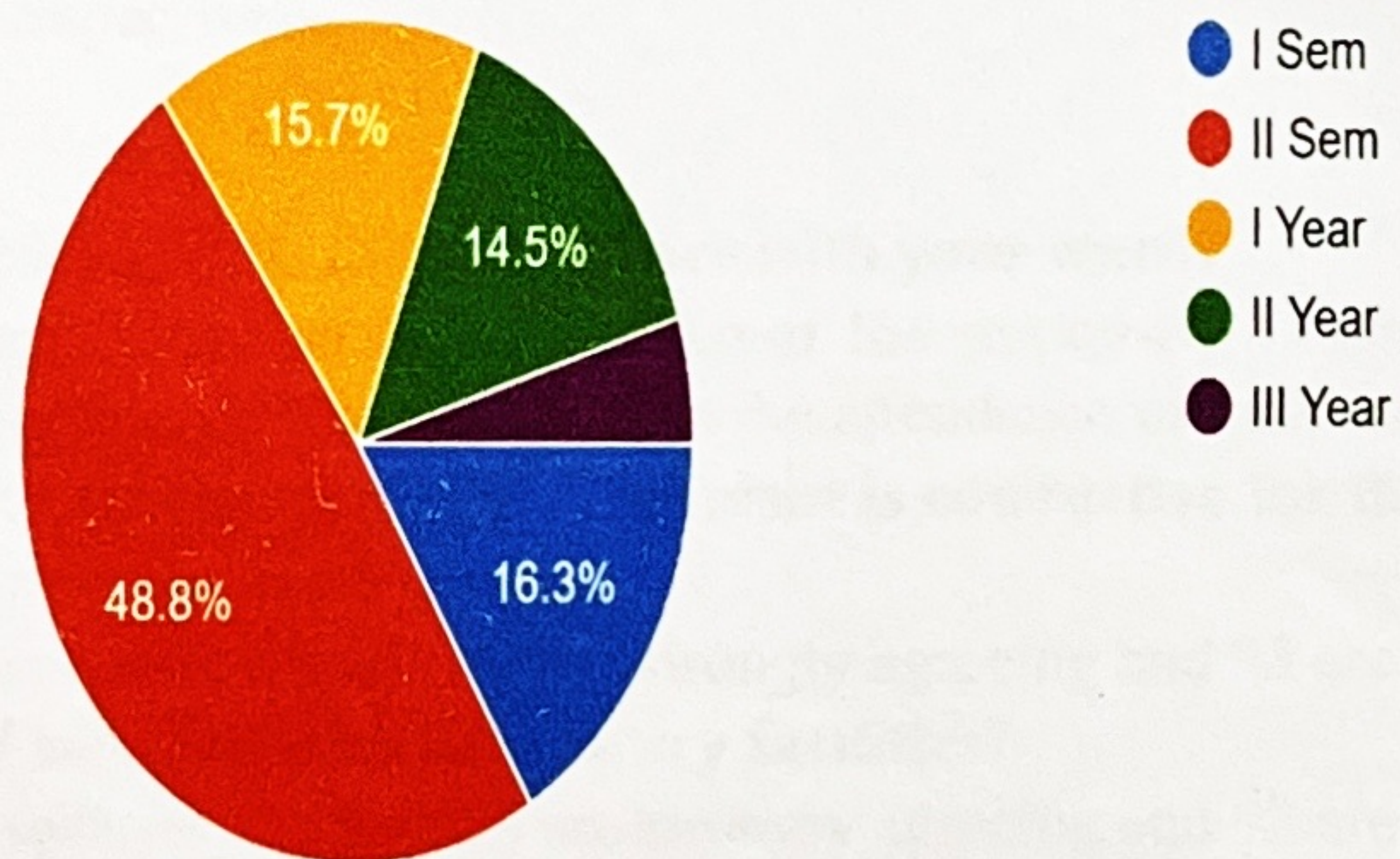

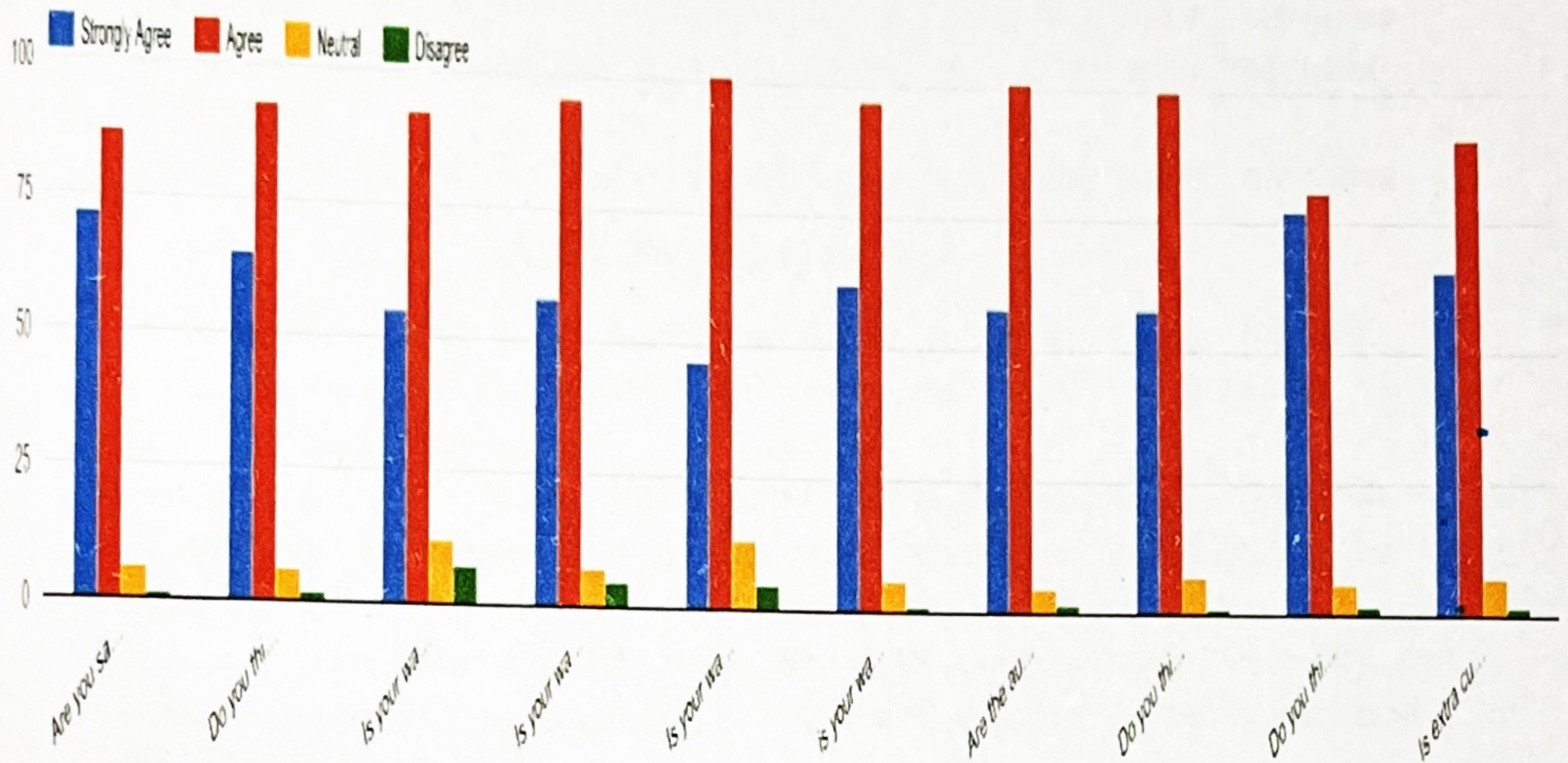

- I. **Are you satisfying with the attendance with your ward?**
The tabular representation shows that out of 166 responses, 72 parents are strongly agree and 87 are agree with the attendance of their ward.
- II. **Do you think that the college environment is conducive for the overall development of your ward?**
Out of 166 responses, 65 parents are strongly agreeing and 93 are agree.
- III. **Is your ward satisfied with the library facilities?**
Out of 166 responses, 55 parents are strongly agreeing and 92 are agree.
- IV. **Is your ward given enough exposure as far as career orientation is concerned?**
Out of 166 responses, 58 parents are strongly agreeing and 96 are agree.

Out of 166 responses, 77 parents are strongly agreeing and 81 are agree.
- X. Is extracurricular activities conducted by college or department is sufficient?**
Out of 166 responses, 66 parents are strongly agreeing and 91 are agree.

Analysis and outcomes:

1. Parents are satisfied with the good environment of the college for the overall development of their wards and have found it to be safe and secure for their children.
2. Parents also found that the children have a good learning experience in the college as a result of the good knowledgeable faculties teaching the children.
