
Student Feedback Analysis Report 2020-21


The IQAC of the college is continuously working on the quality measures to be initiating in all the core areas of the college for the betterment and proper functioning.

The 1QAC prepared the feedback google form & shared it to the students of all streams to get their feedback. The report of their feedback was prepared, analysed and steps were taken accordingly.



Part 227 responses




Subjects 227 responses




Q.1 Syllabus is suitable to the course


Q.2 Has the teacher covered entire syllabus as prescribed by the University




Q.3 Has the teacher covered relevant topic beyond syllabus?




Q.4 Sufficient numbers of prescribed books/reading materials are available in library 227 responses



Q.5 The syllabus has good balance between theory and application 227 responses




Q.6 Teacher interaction and guidance outside the class room 227 responses




Q.7 Communication skill of the teacher




Q.8 Uses of the innovative teaching method




Q.9 The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as 227 responses




Q.10 Whether the assignments and test taken time to time are relevant and useful 227 responses




Q.11 Was your performance in assignments discussed with you 227 responses

OBSERVATIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

• About 45.8 percent students agreed that the teachers covered 100 percent syllabus prescribed by the university while 33 percent students agreed on 80 percent of the syllabus. Remaining syllabus were covered by taking extra classes and online classes. All faculty members instructed to complete the syllabus within the stipulated time.

About 91.6 % students says that teachers have covered the topics beyond the syllabus so that students can gain more knowledge in concerned subjects for future study in masters and competitive examinations in higher education.

- About 83.3 percent students stated that sufficient number of prescribed books/reading materials are available in library. More efforts are being done to motivate students to download e books from N-List. Scanned pdf of local books are provided to students.
- About 52.4 percent students stated that teacher interaction and guidance outside the class room is excellent while 39.6 percent students stated good. Remaining students gave the feedback that it is average/poor. Teachers are advised to make more efforts to provide ample interaction & guidance outside the classrooms as well counsel them.
- About 44.5 percent students were in view that communication skill of teachers is excellent while 51.5 percent students gave feedback of good. Remaining students were in view that it was average/poor. Teachers should make efforts to improve their communication skills. Teachers are encouraged to attend orientation and refreshers courses to learn communication skills.
